



IFT LOBBY DAY Q&A

What to Wear:

Dress for comfort in IFT blue or a shirt from your local. We will have shirts at the staging location as well. Wear comfortable shoes, as you'll be walking around the complex to meet lawmakers, who are housed in different buildings on the complex.

Where to Meet:

The IFT will stage our lobby day at the **Howlett Building, Hall of Flags, located at 501 S. 2nd St., Springfield.** The Howlett Building is one of several buildings on the Capitol Complex. It faces 2nd Street, but the entrance will be on the northwest side, facing the Capitol (the only side of the Howlett that doesn't face a street). Look for the IFT staff wearing red lanyards.

Where to Park:

Most parking lots around the Capitol are assigned and labeled as such. For members driving down to Springfield to participate in lobby day, there is **street parking around the Capitol complex** and at the **IFT Springfield office at 700 S. College.** The surrounding streets around the Capitol building with **meters are: 2nd Street, Monroe, and Edwards.**

What will be provided:

- Lunch will be provided
- Folders with agenda for the day, Capitol map, fact sheets, legislator photos, and office information
- Signs
- T-shirts
